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

THE ESTATE

Château La Tuilière looks out over its vineyards located on two sides of the same hill, of this country which deserves the nickname of little Girondine Switzerland. The body of water in the estuary softens the very sunny microclimate of the vineyard. Long before the widespread development of vines in the region, the very privileged location of its terroir made La Tuiliere one of the very first wine-growing properties and the oldest works report it happening. It is even said From the 20 hectares of vines surrounding the chateau, including

La Tuilière produces a range of red wines and Crémant rose The three grape varieties, namely Merlot, Cabernet-Sauvignon and Malbed create a host of blending possibilities that put their unique stamp on the wines.

VINEYARD MANAGEMENT

The plots are located on clay-limestone soils with some gravel. The average vineyard age is 25 to 30 years.

As independent wine makers we have made a pledge to farm sustainably and are certified Terra Vitis and High Environmenta Value. This certification protects the plant, the product, our people and the environment.



The wines are matured on fine lees using micro-oxygenation in a semi-underground, temperature-controlled cellar. Ageing choices differ depending on the profile of the wines. They can range from concrete and temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks to French oak casks for top-end wines.

The winery is equipped for single vineyard fermentations so that the aroma and flavour profile of each vineyard site can be preserved. This also gives us greater blending possibilities. Pre-fermentation cold soaking, which maximises colour extraction, is followed by alcoholic fermentation.

Displaying a young colour with dark purple highlights, this wine reveals a powerful bouquet of red fruits. Rounded and ample, the palate is supported by generous tannins and is profound with typical Bordeaux

Strict plot selection, crop sorting, alcoholic fermentation in concrete tanks, extraction to promote roundness, ageing partly in oak on the lees, micro-oxygenation.

CRÉMANT DE BORDEAUX "bubbles to discover'

This wine is produced at La Tuilière, a property located exactly at the intersection of the 0° meridian of Greenwich, the origine of the time zones and of the 45° parallel, halfway between the North Pole and the Equator.

Such a strategic position can only give birth to a unique crémant.
